April's Topic: Organizing your Linen Closet

Okay, are you tired of opening up your linen closet door and being surrounded when things come tumbling out?

There's a simple, logical method to stop this from happening and today is a great day to begin making it happen.

First, remove all the items and place them into categories:

- Towels
- Facecloths
- Sheets by size
- Toiletries
- Miscellaneous Items you've just stashed in the space

Next, consider what do you really want to store in this closet? Find better storage spots for those things which don't belong here and place the items used most often in prime closet spots.

For instance, I like to put the similar bedding together — all the twins, full, queen and king sizes. I usually put my pillowcases with the sheets for less confusion. I also use a felt marker to label the tags on the sheets to what size they are.

This way, there is no guess work. You can also label the shelves themselves, so other family members know where things belong.

Finally, if you have room for some toiletries, make sure you place them into clear containers — and always be sure things are clearly labeled.

That didn't take long, did it? Now you can relax when you open the linen closet door! And, no surprises should be falling all over you.
