



## What's under your kitchen sink?

Is the cupboard beneath your sink one of the most neglected areas of your home? I know for many people it is. Just the other day, I was asked to organize a kitchen. My client mentioned that the kitchen counters were getting out of hand, and the kitchen sink had too many things surrounding it and it looked messy. If you're thinking the same thing is happening at your house, be brave!

I can walk you through the steps to a neat and organized cupboard.

The first step is to take everything out from under the kitchen sink. This might be a good time to clean the bottom of the cabinet.

Next, sort the items into categories and really ask yourself "when was the last time I used this product?" You will probably be amazed at how many duplicates and triplicates you have of a product. Do you have a product under the kitchen sink that didn't work well and you are still holding onto the product? Why? How many sets of gloves do you have under there?

Next, find a basket or a Sterilite container that you can place the products in. Then put things into categories. Plus, next time you go to clean under the sink, you will just have to remove 3 bins and not 20 individual containers. It makes sense, doesn't it? Another tip is that by placing the items in a bin, if something tips over, it won't spill all over the cabinet and it will be contained.
