



Ok Ladies, today we are going to talk about our purses.

Then in my second little bag, I have a credit card organizer that holds credit cards or membership cards that I don't use on a daily basis, a few of my business cards, and my name tag.

Then I have a wallet where I keep the 2 credit cards that I use frequently (one for personal and the 2nd card is for my business). The other items included in my wallet are money (I always carry a few bucks on me at all times, I guess you can say that I'm old fashion), driver's license, and receipts. My wallet is large enough where I can keep my receipts in it, but I usually take those receipts out of my wallet when I get home and place it with other receipts in my Tickler folder.

I also keep a small pad of paper, pen, pencil, sharpie marker and my checkbook.

By having these small bags inside my purses, it only takes me minutes to change purses and not hours, like some people....
